I study how the design of compensation contracts, financial incentives, and performancemeasurement and evaluation systems influences the behavior of managers, employees, and investors. I investigate these questions primarily through experimental economics methods but also use survey-based and field experiments.

management, and other core managerial accounting concepts. Previously, I taught applied
